











Plastic recycling numbers explained

Polyethylene Terephthalate		Soft drink, juice and water bottles. Recycle in the blue bin.	
High Density Polyethylene		Milk bottles, bleach, cleaners and most shampoo bottles. Recycle in the blue bin.	
Polyvinyl Chloride		Hard rigid plastic such as pipes, window and door frames. Foam PVC.	
Low Density Polyethylene		Soft plastic such as carrier bags, bin liners, packaging film and film lids.	
Polypropylene		Hard but flexible plastic such as butter tubs, microwavable trays, yoghurt pots. Recycle in the blue bin. No black trays.	
Polystyrene		Brittle and rigid plastic such as plastic cutlery, packaging for electronic goods.	
Other plastics including acrylic, polycarbonate, nylon		Any other plastics that do not fall into the above, eg sunglasses.
