Dear Resident,

Brunton Road / Brunton Lane – Carriageway Resurfacing.

We would like to let you know about road surfacing and associated works we need to undertake on Brunton Road and Brunton Lane. **These works will commence on Tuesday 1st March and will take approximately 10 working days to complete.**

In order to carry out the works safely and efficiently, they will be carried out overnight under temporary road closures with signed diversions in place. The only exceptions to the closures will be vehicles related to the surfacing works and emergency service vehicles.

Works are expected to be scheduled as follows:

- Tuesday 1st March to Friday 4th March carriageway planing / adjustment of ironworks between the hours of 7pm and 11.59pm.
- Monday 7th March to Friday 11th March carriageway surfacing to be undertaken between the hours of 7pm and 7am.

Due to the nature of the works there will be no vehicular access in to, or out of, Dorchester Place between the hours of 10pm and 7am on the following evenings March 1st, 2nd, 7th, 8th and 9th.

Please note all work is weather dependant, so dates and times may change. Even though road surfaces may look complete, please do not attempt to drive over them

before signs and cones have been removed, as this could result in damage to your vehicle or to the new road surface, which must cool before being trafficked.

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times. Cyclists will need to follow signed diversion routes or dismount and push their bike along adjacent footways.

We apologise in advance for the unavoidable noise and disruption, however it will be kept to a minimum at all times.
