### Notice of proposed key decisions and meetings to be held in private

In accordance with the requirements of the Local Authorities (Executive Arrangements) (Meetings and Access to Information) (England) Regulations 2012 ("the Regulations" which came into effect on 10 September 2012), this document gives 28 clear days' notice of the key decisions which the Council intends to make.

The Council is no longer statutorily required to publish a Forward Plan, but this document also sets out details of decisions in the next 4 months (it may include decisions to be made by Cabinet or individual Cabinet Members and Officers which are not key decisions). This document also gives notice of the Council's intention that all or parts of the following meetings shall be held in private:

### Cabinet at 6.00pm on 25 November 2024 (part of meeting in private)

This document sets out the items which are to be considered in private at the above-mentioned meeting(s). Any representations as to why any item should not be considered in private must be sent to the Service Manager Democratic Services at the address shown below.

The Council will publish a further notice 5 clear days before the relevant meeting which will give the Council's response to any such representations.

### In accordance with Regulation 9 of the Regulations this document provides the following information:

- that a key decision is to be made on behalf of Newcastle City Council,
- the matter in respect of which the decision is to be made,
- where the decision maker is an individual, his/her name and position and, where the decision taker is a body, its name and details of membership,
- the date on which, or the period within which, the decision will be taken,
- a list of the documents submitted to the decision maker for consideration in relation to the matter in respect of which the key decision is to be made.
- the address from which, subject to any prohibition or restriction on their disclosure, copies of, or extracts from, any document listed is available,
- that other documents relevant to those matters may be submitted to the decision maker; and the procedure for requesting details of those documents (if any) as they become available.

### Key decisions are those executive decisions which are likely-

- to result in the Council incurring expenditure which is, or the making of savings which are, **significant** having regard to the Council's budget for the service or function to which the decision relates; or
- to be **significant** in terms of their effects on communities living or working in an area comprising two or more wards in the City.

The following will not usually be key decisions:

- matters involving revenue expenditure of £250,000 or less,
- matters involving capital expenditure of £1,000,000 or less; and
- matters involving land and property within the delegations of the Head of Property.

The Government has published guidance on the meaning of 'significant'.

### **Housing Complaints:**

Last month, Cabinet approved a regulatory action plan for Council Housing, which identified that our complaint handling process is not fully embedded.

The Council has conducted a new self-assessment against the Housing Ombudsman Code for Complaint Handling and will be publishing this alongside actions to improve complaint handling.

The Housing Ombudsman has also noted that the 2023/24 Annual Complaints Performance and Service Improvement Report, published in June 2024, was not published with comments from the governing body alongside as required by the Code for Complaint Handling. YHN Board were the relevant governing body at the time and resigned shortly afterwards as part of the transfer of services. In order to meet the Ombudsman requirements for accountability, the Council is re-publishing the Annual Report, sharing an update on complaints handling since then, and including the comments of Cabinet on performance.

### **Fire Compartmentation Surveys:**

Compartmentation is the key passive fire protection measure that allows our stay put fire approach. We need to ensure that these systems are intact, and where breaches are found they are recorded and remediated across out High Rise Homes portfolio. The need to complete these surveys has been flagged through our fire risk assessment works.

To ensure this tender is published quickly but also to ensure that the specification covers all technical areas it is requested that this is done with a specialist procurement partner such as Prosper. Prosper have an existing Passive Fire Safety Framework that could be used to procure a compliant and competent contractor to undertake both the survey and remedial work. ### **Mental health support options:**

This is a new contract structure which covers support options in a range of housing and community settings for people with mental health issues.
