38. Apologies for Absence

39. Minutes

40. Matters Arising from the previous meeting

Members commented as follows -

- The issue of mud on the highway at east end of Coach Lane had been resolved.
- The Caravan was still parked on the path on Elliott Walk. It was agreed that this should be raised with the Police
- Members asked for information from the City Council relating to action taken by the Enforcement team relating to domestic rubbish tipped on the play field.

41. Environment and Highways Matters

Members raised the following issues -

- It was noted that despite raising the matter some months ago, the van and rubble were still on the grass verge on North View, and the unauthorised driveway still in use. City councillors believed a response had been forthcoming from highways and the Clerk undertook to obtain an update.
- Members requested confirmation from the City Council that spraying of weed killer would not be undertaken in the areas where wildflower seeds had been planted.
- Members commented on the uncertainty of the location or re-location of the westbound bus stop following completion of the works currently underway to provide a new crossing and relocated eastbound bus stop.

Members considered the estimated expenditure for the coming year and were of the opinion that there was no need to raise the level of the precept. It was therefore -
