

**Newcastle City Council Healthier Food Environments
Supplementary Planning Document 2024
Adoption Statement**

In accordance with Regulations 11 and 14 of the Town and Country Planning (Local Planning) (England) Regulations 2012, notice is given that Newcastle City Council adopted the Healthier Food Environments Supplementary Planning Document on 17 June 2024.

Any person with sufficient interest in the decision to adopt the supplementary planning document may make an application to the High Court for permission to apply for judicial review of the decision. Any such application must be made promptly in any event no later than 3 months after the date on which the supplementary planning document was adopted.

Title:

Newcastle City Council Healthier Food Environments Supplementary Planning Document.

Subject Matter:

To ensure that planning can support the council's aim to support individuals, families and communities to access, adopt and sustain healthier diets, Planning Policy have prepared supplementary planning policies to take forward in a new SPD as part of a wider effort to tackle unhealthy diets. SPDs are used to provide more detail on policies and policy approaches set out in an adopted Local Plan. The Healthier Food Environments SPD will help the council address our priorities including to tackle poverty – where everyone is free to live healthy, happy lives.

The Healthier Food Environments SPD sets out policy guidance and consideration on:

- Locations where children and young people congregate
- Over-proliferation
- Over-concentration
- Clustering
- Protection of residential amenity
- Highway issues
- Hours of operation
- Levels of obesity
- Odours and noise abatement
- Disposal of waste products

Area Covered:

The Healthier Food Environments Supplementary Planning Document applies to planning applications for new-build and changes of use, covering hot food takeaways and mixed-use premises where takeaway food sales are not incidental to the main use.
